



La Purito Andorra 2022 Rules

Art. 1.- La Purito Andorra 2022 is a one day cyclist tour open to all federated and non-federated cyclists over the age of 18 to travel 4.8 and 3.5, and from 13 years to 1.7. La Purito Andorra 2022 is a non-competitive event that will be developed at all times by roads open to traffic, which means that all participants must exercise extreme caution throughout the itinerary, always respecting the road traffic.

La Purito Andorra 2022 is organised by Sprint Club Andorra, with the collaboration of the Government of Andorra and all the Communes of the Parishes included in the tour.

Art. 2.- La Purito Andorra 2022 will have the official start of route 4.8 and 3.5 at 08:00 and the start of route 1.7 at 08:20 on Sunday 7th of August, next to the Sant Julià de Lòria Sports Center located on Avinguda Verge de Canòlich, 50 - AD600 SANT JULIÀ de LÒRIA (Principality of Andorra). 4.8 route will be of 115 km, route 3.5 will be of 80 km and route 1.7 will be of 28 km. To finish all the routes at the top of the Cortals d'Encamp, where the finish line will close at 18:00.

Art. 3.- Registration rights:

Registration dates will be from January 14th, 2022 to June 30, 2022 or until a maximum of 1.800 participants.

Rates 4.8 - 3.5 and 1.7:

- From January 14th to March 31st: 55€
- From April 1st to May 31st : 65€
- From June 1st to June 30th: 75€
- In all routes and registrations non-federated participants must pay 10€ of day insurance.
- Registration is personal and non-transferable and implies acceptance of all the articles of these regulations, as well as the purchase conditions.
- All prices appear in the registration form on this website and can be processed through the online payment system with a credit or debit card.
- Changes in jersey size will be accepted until June 30th.
- Changes of distances from 4.8 to 3.5 or 1.7 and vice versa will be accepted until June 30th.
- Name changes will be accepted until June 30th, provided that the two participants have the same jersey size.

The day insurance provides medical coverage to the physical injuries suffered by the participant, not covering the material damage to the bicycle or accessories, as well as the damage caused to third parties.

The service can be contracted at the time of registration.

Returns and changes policy:

In case of not being able to participate, the following table will be used as a return policy:

Until April 30th - 100% refund

From May 1st to May 31st -80% refund of registration..

From June 1st to June 30th - 50% refund of registration.

From July 1st: no refund can be made, no modification or change or change of the resource reserved for registration can be made.

Those participants who cannot participate in the 2022 edition and want to save the registration to 2023 must communicate it before April 30th, after this date, all those registered who have not requested this reservation to 2023, will be governed by the return policy mentioned.

Art. 4.- To participate it is mandatory to be in possession of the corresponding road cycling license approved by the UCI or FAC, or to subscribe the day license with the insurance provided by the organization. They are the only valid insurance accepted by the authorities. Other licences like triathlon are not allowed.

The participation in the tour is under the responsibility and own risk of the participants. The participant at the time of registration states that he / she is physically fit for the tour.

Art. 5.- The organization will provide the following mandatory material for all participants:

- The high-rage jersey HIRU, included with the registration is MANDATORY to wear it during the route for good control of the organization and police service personnel. If the participant does not wear the jersey, he will not be able to participate in the following editions of La Purito Andorra.
- A dorsal to be placed in the front of the bicycle.
- A mask for mandatory use for departure, refreshments and arrival.
- A participant bracelet that must be kept on during the whole march, to make use of the mechanical service, medical service, refreshments, finisher trophy and access to the exclusive area of participants in the arrival area.
- It is very important that during the registration process the table showing the measurements of the jersey HIRU before CHOOSING THE SIZE IS WELL STUDIED. Also the jersey is very fitted and if you prefer not to go so tight, it's worth taking a size up.

Art. 6.- The registrations will be made through the payment gateway of and the returns will be governed according to the contracting rules.

Art. 7.- The registration 4.8, 3.5 and 1.7 includes, commemorative jersey of the tour La Purito Andorra 2022 and numbered plate, control chip, welcome pack, refreshment, food on arrival, mechanical service, trophy and Finisher diploma.

Art 8.- The number collection will be delivered in the Cultural Center and Congresses Lauredià. Plaça de la Germandat, 4-5-6 of Sant Julia de Lòria. On Saturday 6th of August from 10am to 8pm.

All participants must carry, in a mandatory and visible way: the license plate on the front of the bicycle. The cyclist who does not have the bicycle license plate visible or the advertising items of the plate will be excluded from the tour by members of the organization or by the forces of order.

The plate and the chip are personal and non-transferable items. The registered person can only participate with the plate that has been assigned and agree not to allow the use of it to other people.

The assignment of the numbered plates will be Red for 4.8, Blue for route 3.5 and Yellow for route 1.7.

Art. 9.- To collect the race bib, jersey and welcome pack, it will be MANDATORY to present the documentation required by the health authorities and that we will communicate through the participant's dossier days prior to the celebration of La Purito, be a photograph of the DNI or NIE and the cycling license. In the event that the insurance proposed by the organisation has not been taken out, for those under 18 years of age it is compulsory to present the parental authorisation (download the attached sheet) duly signed, in the event that the licence is not presented, 10 € will be charged for the compulsory day insurance to participate in the race.

Art. 10.- THE USE OF THE APPROVED CYCLING HELMET IS OBLIGATORY.

Art. 11.- The route will be duly marked.

Art. 12.- The organization will have during the development of the tour: four ambulances, in strategic points of the route and a PMA (Advanced Medical Point) in the arrival line.

Art. 13.- The organization will have mechanical assistance vehicles throughout the route but it is not obliged to provide service to all participants. In case of breakdown, the labour will be free, but the spare parts will be borne by the participants. Only repairs that can be solved in route will be taken into account. All participants must carry their spare parts and be self-sufficient. All participants must take their bicycle in perfect condition, as well as their spare parts and be self-sufficient. The mechanical assistance of the organization is a courtesy service.

Art. 14.- The refreshment points will be located at:

4.8 Route

- Coll de la Gallina (km 40) - Solid and liquid
- La Comella (km 60) - Liquid
- Encamp (km 67) - Solid and liquid
- Coll d'Ordino (km 93) - Solid and liquid
- Arrival (km 115) - Solid and liquid

3.5 Route

- Coll de la Gallina (km 40) - Solid and liquid
- La Comella (km 60) - Liquid
- Encamp (km 67) - Solid and liquid
- Arrival (km 80) - Solid and liquid

1.7 Route

- La Comella (km 10) - Liquid
- Arrival (km 30) - Solid and liquid

Art. 15.- The Finisher Trophy will be delivered at the finish line till 6:00 PM.

Art. 16.- Cutting times.

A schedule is scheduled for Encamp supply, which will affect participants in the 4.8 and 3.5 course with the following schedules:

- At 14:00 p.m., the access to the 4.8 route will be closed, while the participant who arrives later will be diverted directly to Els Cortals d'Encamp.
- The refreshment at Els Cortals d'Encamp will be closed at 15:00.
- At 17:00 the access to Els Cortals d'Encamp will be closed.

At 6:00 PM the arrival control will be closed and the 2022 edition of La Purito Andorra will be finished.

Art. 17.- The Finisher of the La Purito Andorra 2022 will be considered as any participant who completes the tour 4.8, 3.5 and 1.7 in its entirety, within the hours scheduled by the organization.

Art. 18.- The Finisher Trophy will be delivered once the finish line is crossed till 6:00 PM.

Art. 19.- All the participants must take heed and follow the rules of the road, the test runs along roads open to traffic. Who does not comply with the rules of circulation will be expelled from the tour and subsequent editions. The inscription in the tour supposes that the participant assumes the risks inherent to the participation in a road open to traffic, and excludes the organization from the responsibility for any incident or accident derived from the participation in the road.

Art. 20.- The organization is not responsible for any accident that could be cause or victim the participant, which must be covered by the corresponding federal license or accident insurance contracted to the organization in case of not being federated. Neither is it jointly and severally liable for the expenses or debts incurred by the participants during the tour, nor for the loss or damage that may be suffered by the bicycles or other equipment of the participants. The participant exempts the organization from any responsibility for loss or deterioration of personal objects for any reason.

Art. 21.- The organization reserves the right to make the appropriate modifications, when for any reason it deems necessary. Likewise, the Admission Right is reserved.

Art. 22.- Image rights. The acceptance of this regulation implies that the participant authorizes the organizers of the LA PURITO ANDORRA 2022 to the total or partial recording of their participation in the same, agrees to use their image for the promotion and dissemination of the image of the tour in all its forms (radio, press, video, photo, DVD, internet, posters, media, etc.) and gives all rights related to commercial and advertising exploitation that they consider appropriate to execute, without the right to receive any financial compensation. This article is also extensible to photographs.

Art. 23.- The mere fact of registering for this event implies acceptance of these regulations and the waiver of all rights against the organization, waiving any legal action that may arise from their participation in the tour.

Art. 24.- Strictly, the penalty will be made for those participants who:

- Do not respect traffic regulations.
- Do not respect the safety instructions indicated by the Police and by the organization.
- Do not go through the exit control and by others located on the route.
- Mess or degrade the itinerary, throwing away waste.
- Behaviours that prevent the normal development of the tour and that go against this regulation.

The Police and the organization will take note of those who perform some of the behaviours indicated above.

The organization acquires the commitment in front of the rest of the participants and the authorities to sanction them in an effective way.

The penalty will be:

- Disqualification of the tour, without the right to a Finisher trophy
- Inclusion in the lists of sanctioned participants, for later publication.
- Prohibition to participate in other editions of the tour.
- The sanctions imposed by the authorities, to which by their attitude could be made worthy.

Art. 25.- The organization will not assume any responsibility if the event is suspended or postponed due to force majeure.

Art. 26.- Participants are strongly recommended to have a medical examination before participating in the tour.

Art. 27.- The participant authorizes the processing and transfer of their data to the Organizing and collaborating entities of this event in order to process the registration in the event and to manage everything related to the participation in the tour. It also authorizes the processing and transfer of data to the organizing, sponsoring and collaborating entities of this event available at www.lapuritoandorra.com, for advertising and commercial prospecting purposes, so that these entities can direct offers of products and services that they are marketed by any means, including by email, SMS or any other equivalent means of electronic communication.
